

This application to register a political party must be accompanied by the name and mailing address of at least 250 electors and their declaration that they are a member of the party and support its application for registration.

The party must submit all members' information and declarations to Elections Canada with the application for registration. Declarations must be signed by hand; electronic signatures or signatures that have been altered are not accepted.

The information must be **complete** and **legible**.

The party may print or photocopy this page to collect the 250 signatures required.
